Variant1	Classroom Module: (Till JSTS exam in January / February 2019)	Fee : Rs.18,500/-
Variant 2	Test Series for JSTSE	Fee : Rs.6,000/-

Variant 1	Full program consisting of classes, material and tests. The program is of approximately 55-60 hours duration. Classes to be conducted for 2 hours per week on some weekday starting 4 th week of April 1 Full length test per month from September – January. Each test will be of 3¼ hours duration. A total of 5 tests will be conducted.
Variant 2	Students can appear for the monthly tests from September 2018 till January 2019. A total of 5 tests will be conducted.

JUNIOR SCIENCE TALENT SEARCH EXAMINATION - CLASS IX

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Junior Science Talent Search (JSTS) Examination is one of the prestigious competitive examinations held by Directorate of Education Delhi for the students of Class IX or equivalent. The Directorate of Education awards 150 scholarships each year. The purpose of this scheme is to identify brilliant students at the end of Class IX. Selection is made on the basis of competitive Test of Class IX students who have secured at least 65% marks in Class VIII. The examination is normally conducted during the months of January / February.

Written Test (multiple choice questions) is conducted in the following subjects.

Syllabus: - There is no prescribed syllabus for the above said examination. However, the standard of questions shall be conforming to the level of Class VIII and IX. However a few questions may be asked from the Class X syllabus (very rarely).
