Pre-Matric, Post-Matric and Merit-Cum-Means based Scholarship Schemes 2018-19.

Last date for submission of Online applications for Post-Matric and Merit-Cum-Means Scholarship (Fresh and Renewal)	Upto 31st October, 2018

**Eligibility:**

- The applicant should belong to any one form the notified minority communities' viz. Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Zoroastrians (Parsis) and Jains.
- Pursuing studies in India in Government or Private Universities/Institutes/Colleges/Schools.
- The course being pursued is of one or more years.
- The applicant should have secured 50% marks in the last annual Board/Class examination.
- Income certificate in the name of parents issued by competent authorities of GNCT of Delhi, valid at the time of submission of application.
