Under this campaign, participants get exclusive access to images of the sky taken by 24", 30" and 32" telescopes positioned in Astronomical Research Institute (ARI) Observatory, USA. They download these images and analyze the data with specialized software provided during training to search for asteroids. Objects reported by students could be potential discoveries. Our Students enrolled for Phase I (from June 12 to July 10, 2020). There was an online training workshop for the selected students. The workshop included background about the program, understanding AIASC, software installation, hands-on practice, and how to access the data and report it. A special practice session with real discovery data was held at the end of the session. After the training, students downloaded and analyzed the data by themselves on their computers, and later they uploaded the reports of their observation to the IASC.
