

## Stream/Subjects Allocation Criterion for Class XI - 2022-23

1. There will be three sections each for the Science and Commerce streams, and one for Humanities.
2. The choice of stream/subjects of parents/students will be taken. This will be a survey but **will not guarantee any allotment of the choice.**
3. The stream/subject allocation will be as per the **MERIT** from within all seekers of that stream/subject, ensuring that no subject teacher gets to teach, at a time, more than 38 students. No section will have more than 38 students. **The Grand total of the marks in three Unit / Periodic tests and Term I for each subject** will be taken into consideration to prepare the Merit list.
4. The merit lists will be made as per the following criterion:
  - **Science stream:** For the grant of science stream, there will be 3 conditions:
    1. The student must want science subjects,
    2. The student must be among the top 114 students in terms of his/her total marks of (Maths, Science and the Grand total).
  - **Commerce stream:** Students will be eligible for commerce stream if:
    1. They have asked for it as their first choice.
    2. They had science as their first choice but could not get, and their second/third choice is commerce.
    3. Total of 114 students will be granted the Commerce stream, 76 students will be given Commerce with Maths as per the Merit list and 38 students will be given Commerce without Maths.
    4. For Commerce with Maths, merit list will be made on the basis of the total of marks in Maths and the Grand Total .
  - **Humanities stream:** This will be given on the basis of Merit to all those students who have opted for the stream and also those who could not be granted Science / Commerce stream.
