Students of KG G, presented a colourful , musical extravaganza on the festival of colours `Holi`.

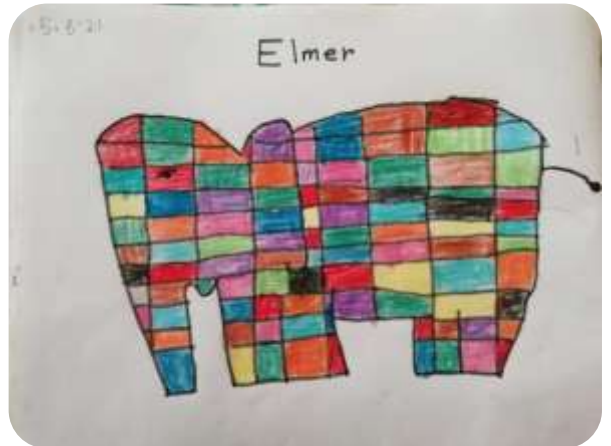


Class Party:

CLASS II:-

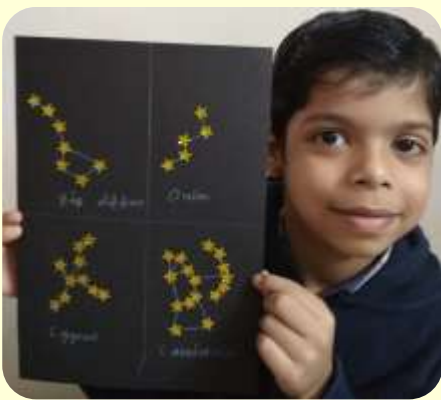
a) 'MAKING CONSTELLATIONS' related to the lesson Star Tales . (ENGLISH)
