Sir/Madam,

The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPDR) is an apex statutory body of Government of India established in 2007 under the Commissions for Protection of Child Rights (CPCR) Act, 2005. The Commission's mandate is to ensure that all laws, policies, programmes, and administrative mechanisms are in consonance with the child rights perspective, as enshrined in the Constitution of India and the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC). In addition, the Commission has the mandate under Section 109 of the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection) of Children Act, 2015 to monitor the provisions provided under the said Act.

2. To spread Child Rights literacy under section 13(1)(h) of CPCR Act, 2005, NCPDR is initiating a competition for school students, students in hostels, and children residing in Child Care Institutions. The competition has been divided into two groups (1) for students of class 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> and (2) for class 6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>. This is a platform for children to empower them of their rights and entitlements. Children have to select right answer from the multiple options given under a questionnaire under different theme on Child Rights on NCPDR's website on [www.ncpcr.gov.in](http://www.ncpcr.gov.in). The link <https://ncpcr.gov.in/champions> at NCPDR's website for registration and participation will be open from 12<sup>th</sup> January, 2023 on the occasion of "National Youth Day" and will be closed on 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2023. The details along with a write up and guidelines can be seen at the link mentioned above. After completion of response to the questionnaire the children will get a digital certificate for participation.

3. Districts and States for effective execution of competition shall be provided with certificate of appreciation on the occasion of NCPDR's 18<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day.

4. For promoting gender equality and showcasing the inspiring stories of Girl Child, the Commission is in a process of making a small documentary.
