Excellence in academics is the hallmark of any good institution and X and XII results of the school prove without an iota of doubt that Modernites have made us proud.

I feel elated to say that in class XII in the Commerce stream Anjali Jain topped with an enviable score of 98.6% followed by Prerna Dewan who topped the humanities stream with 98.4% and Akshit Rewliya topped the Science stream with 98%.

Anjali Jain, Aditya Singhania, Naman Jain and Muskan Mittal scored a perfect 100 in Economics. In Political Science, Prerna Dewan and Khyati Pareek scored 100. Akshit Rewliya scored 100 in Chemistry and Prerna Dewan scored 100 in Psychology. Sanna Saini scored a perfect 100 in Commercial Art.

In Mathematics, Computer Science, Business Studies, Informatics Practices & Accountancy the highest score was 99% followed by 98% in Sociology and Physical Education while the highest score in Physics, and English was 97%. In Biology the highest score was 95% and in Engineering Graphics it was 93%.

Class X result was also exemplary. Paras Jain and Tanisha Panesar made their alma mater proud by clinching 95.6% in the aggregate.

In class X, a perfect 100 was scored in French by 6 students and 100 in Mathematics by 3 students. In Hindi, Science and Social Science the highest score was 99, followed by 97 in English.

Young and dynamic science exuberant of MPS got selected in JEE MAINS with an enviable percentile of 99.90%.

1. SCHOOL ON WHEELS

- 5. Adult literacy club: The club addresses the use of computer knowledge to combat illiteracy and move the adults directly to computer literacy. The approach provides an interactive, self-paced, autonomous and entertaining learning experience to the elderly and homemakers above the age of 35 in vicinity of the school.

SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS
